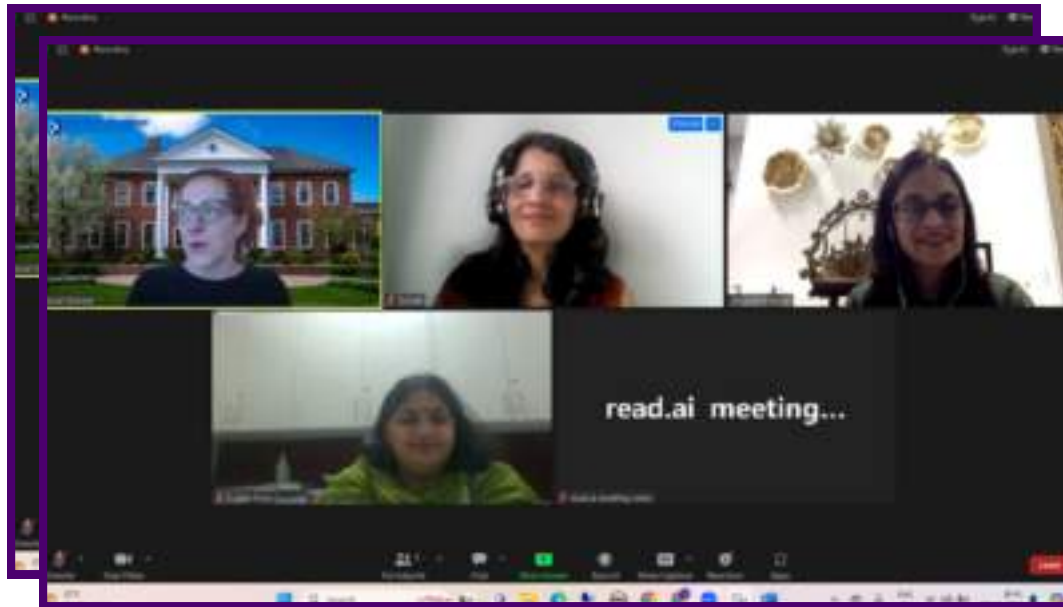
SIU:

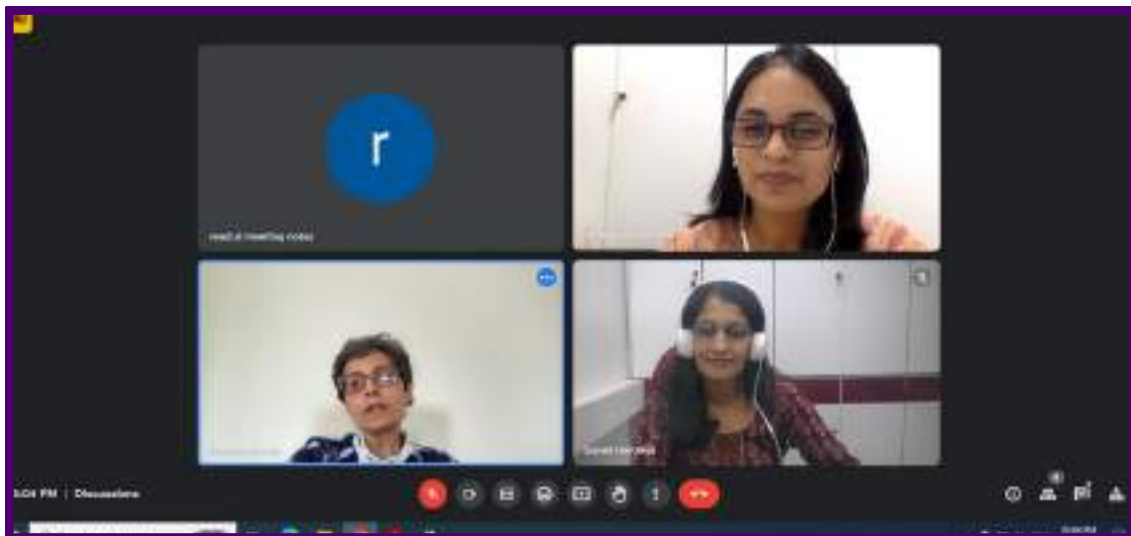

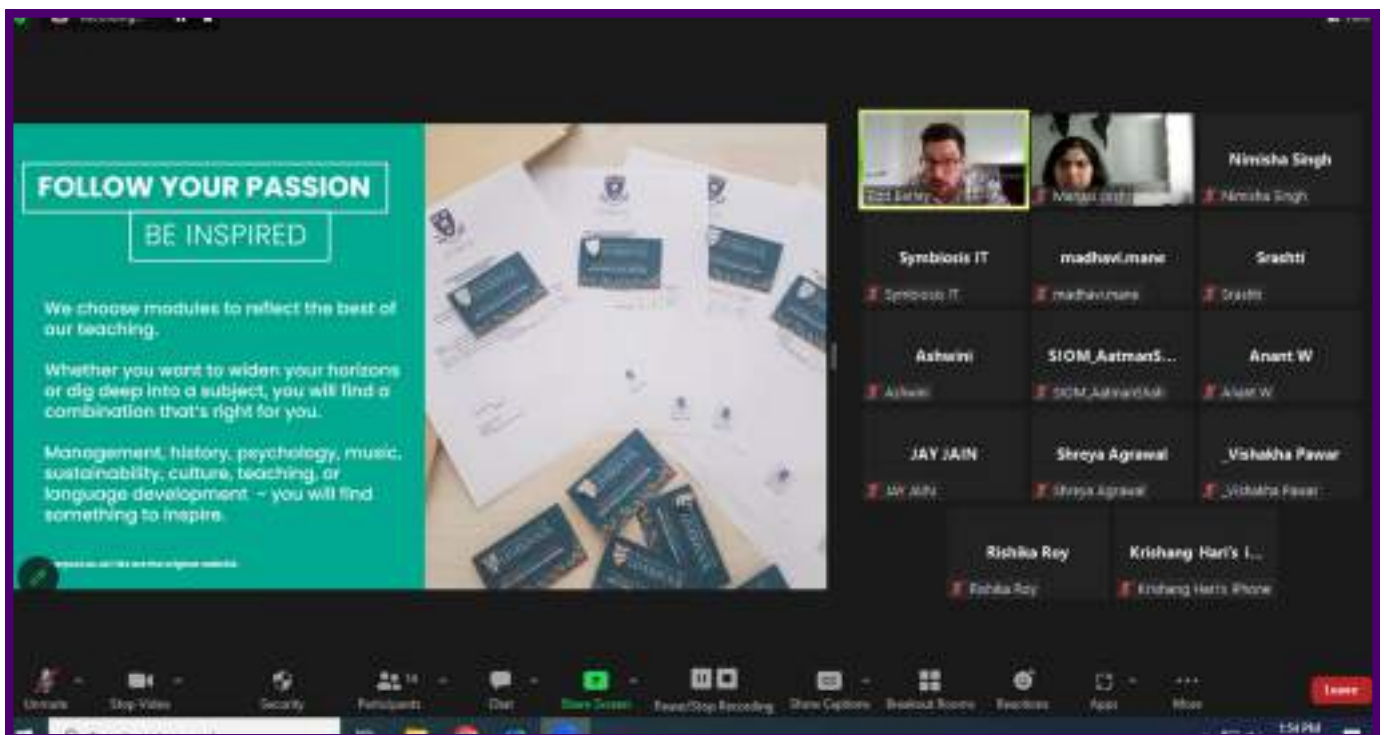

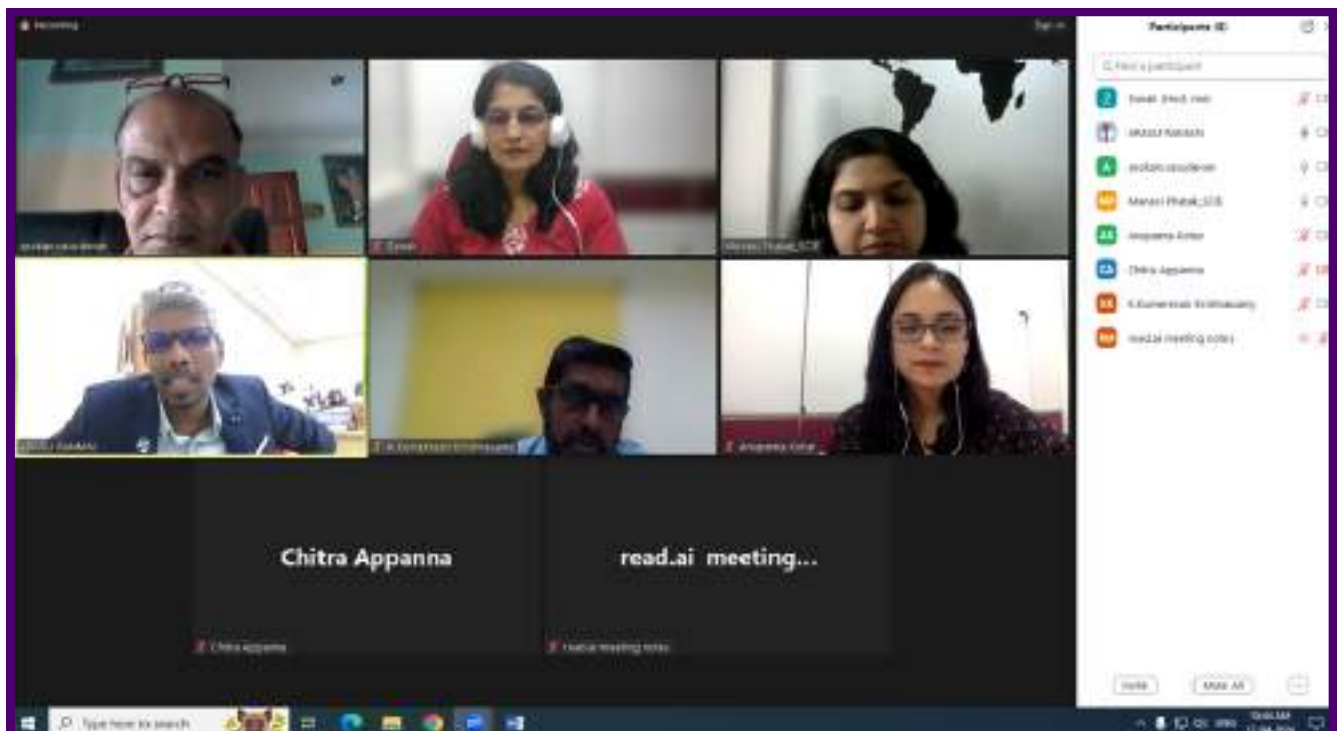


SCIE conducted a session with the University of Liverpool for upcoming opportunities like Summer schools
